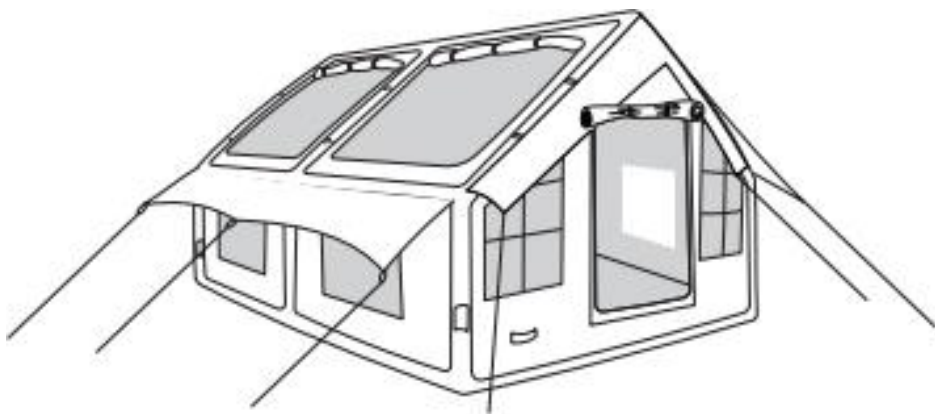

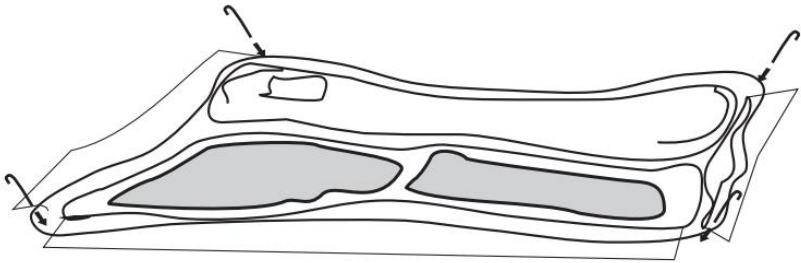

ASSEMBLY STEP

(Tenting Instructions)

STEP- 1

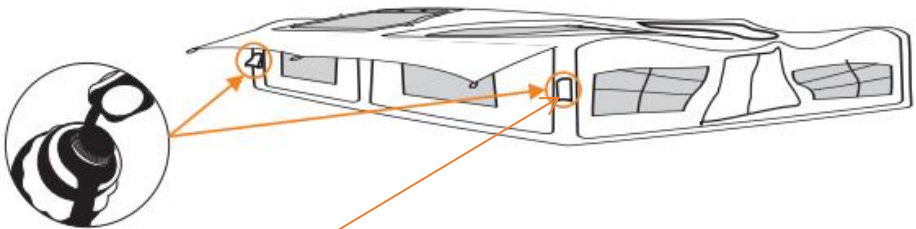
Start by preparing the site. Remove any trash and objects that could potentially damage the tent. Ensure the location is level and devoid of sharp objects. Then, unfold the tent and insert stakes into its corners.



STEP- 2

The tent comes with two external air valves.

Before inflating the tent, make sure to close one of these valves.

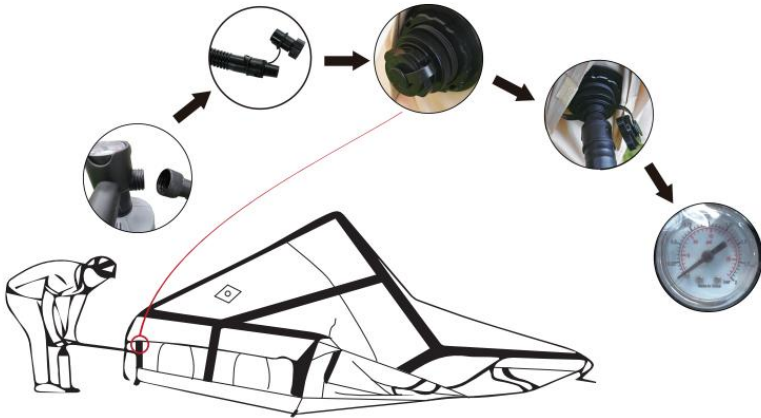


※ Check and tighten the deflation valve before use.

STEP- 3

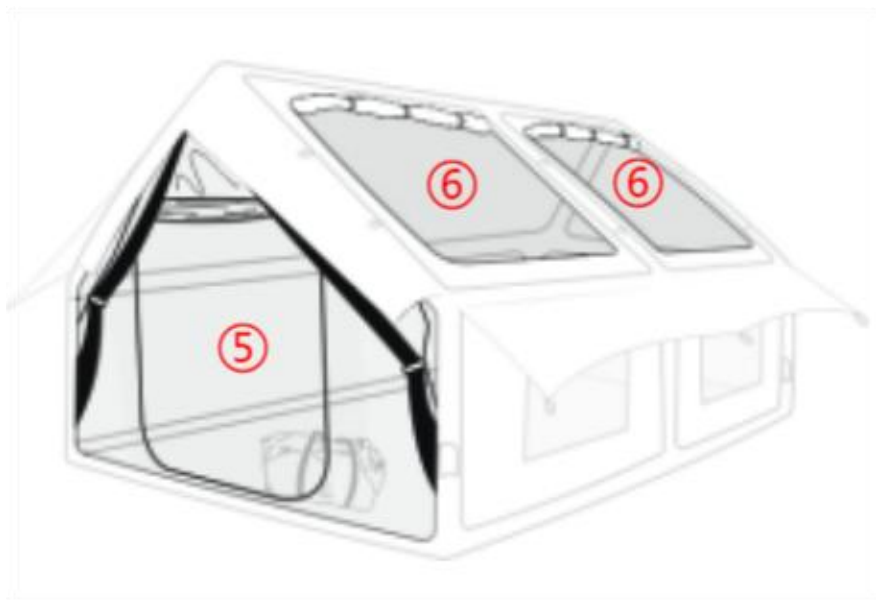
Install the pump head and fix it to the valve.

Keep inflating the tent until the air column can fully stand up, then the inflation is completed. Please do not over-inflate the tent or it will be in danger especially in summer days. The ideal pressure for tent inflation is between 6 and 8 pounds per square inch



STEP- 4

Install transparent door 5 and transparent window 6 according to personal needs.



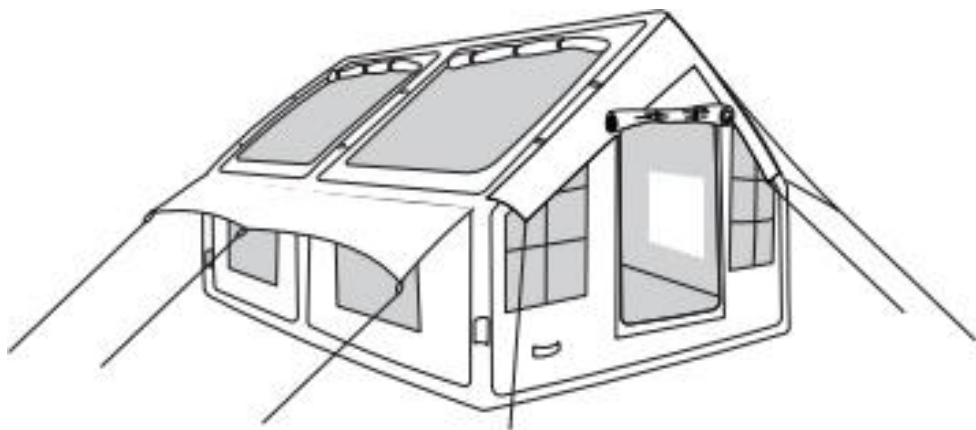
STEP- 5

On rainy days, covering a yurt with a rain fly can provide better waterproofing



STEP- 6

Tighten the valve cover and secure the tent with guy ropes and and pegs.

**Safety Warning:**

Please do not over-inflate the tent or the air column of the tent will damage.

Special attention when using in hot summer days.

When the temperature rises, do not fill the column completely.

Please reduce the amount of inflating as appropriate as the air column may burst due to the expansion of air by heat.

*** It is recommended to dry the product before storing it to avoid mildew**

(Folding Tent Instructions)

STEP- 1

Unscrew the valve of the inflatable tent's nozzle to deflate it.



STEP- 2

Remove the tent ground pegs and stow the wind ropes away. Spread the tent out flat. Fold the sides of the tent toward the center, then fold them in half (Approx. 29.53in/75cm).



STEP- 3

Folding the tent to fit in the organizer bag (.Note: Do not roll the tent from the side of the air vent!)

STEP- 4

Place in the organizer bag.
